



This activity will guide you using simple shapes and details to draw a picture of an imaginary house.


STEPS:




Draw a rectangle




Draw a triangle




Erase the middle line



Draw the left roof




Draw the right roof




Erase 2 lines where the roofs meet



Add a door and window



Add a rectangle below the window + a circle window



Draw 2 steps to the door



Draw a chimney, Add frames door handle, + plants



to both windows

SLOPE - TO SLANT UP OR DOWN
