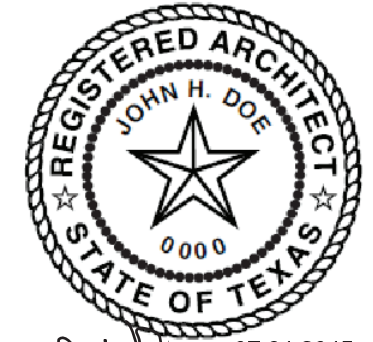

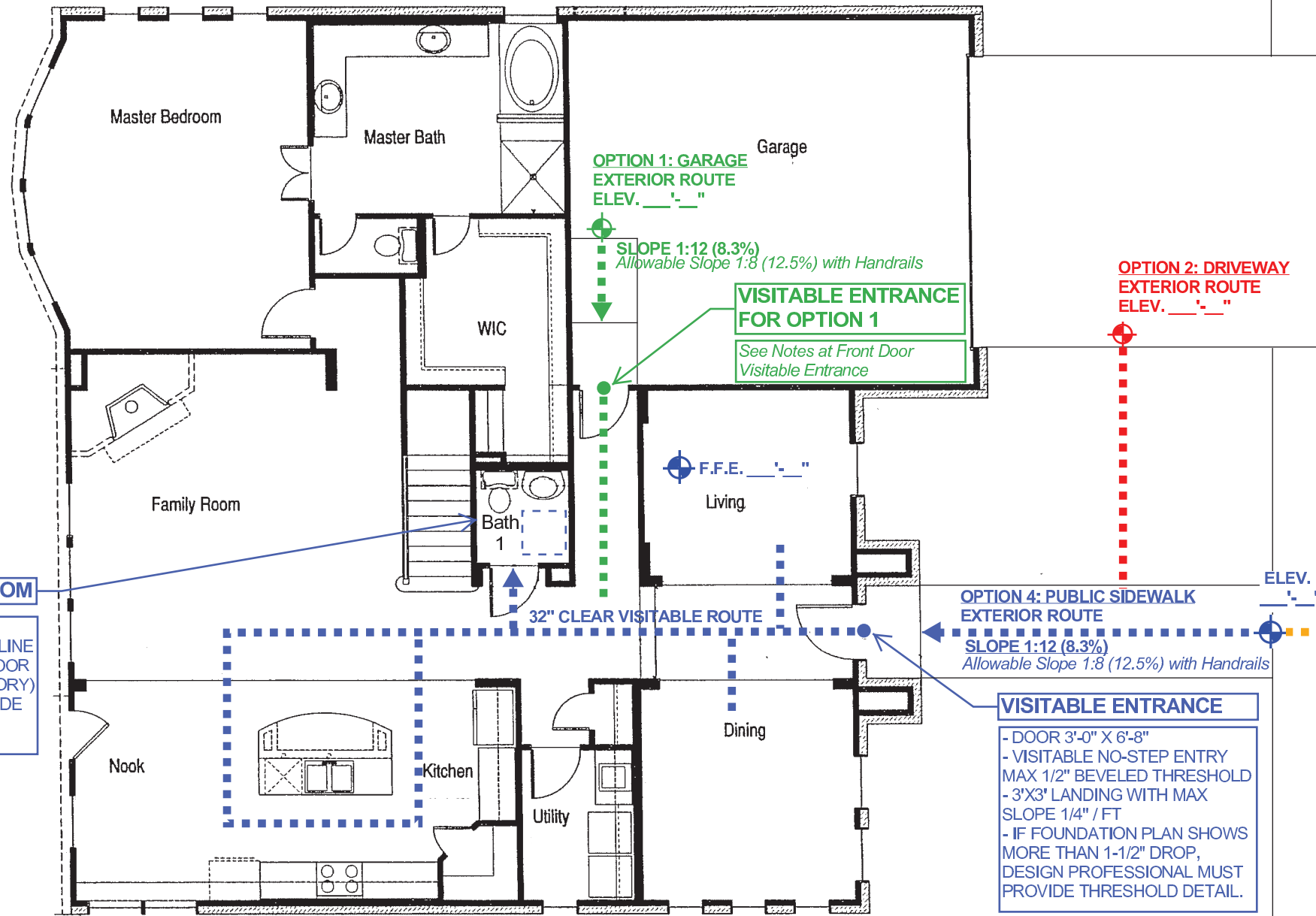

BENCHMARK ELEVATION

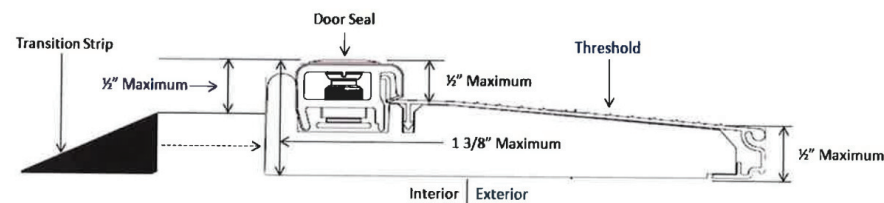


### VISITABLE BATHROOM

- DOOR 2'-8" X 6'-8"
- 2x6 BLOCKING CENTERLINE AT 34" ABOVE FINISH FLOOR (EXCEPT BEHIND LAVATORY)
- DOOR SHALL NOT IMPEDE 30" X 30" CLEAR FLOOR SPACE

### VISITABLE ENTRANCE

- DOOR 3'-0" X 6'-8"
- VISITABLE NO-STEP ENTRY MAX 1/2" BEVELED THRESHOLD
- 3'X3' LANDING WITH MAX SLOPE 1/4" / FT
- IF FOUNDATION PLAN SHOWS MORE THAN 1-1/2" DROP, DESIGN PROFESSIONAL MUST PROVIDE THRESHOLD DETAIL.



### APPROVED THRESHOLD DETAIL

REFER TO CODE INTERPRETATION CI2013-0002 FOR ADDITIONAL INFORMATION.  
IF FOUNDATION PLAN SHOWS MORE THAN A 1-1/2" DROP, DESIGN PROFESSIONAL MUST PROVIDE THRESHOLD DETAIL.

### VISITABILITY NOTES:

1. LIGHT SWITCHES AND ENVIRONMENTAL CONTROLS NO HIGHER THAN 48" ABOVE THE INTERIOR FLOOR LEVEL
2. OUTLETS AND RECEPTACLES MINIMUM 15" ABOVE INTERIOR FLOOR LEVEL EXCEPT FOR FLOOR OUTLETS

When a Waiver is requested per R320.7.1, a survey shall be provided with topographic information performed by a Texas Registered Professional Land Surveyor.
